# RDN Northern Economic Development Grant - Entrepreneurs Toolkit Workshops

In November the Qualicum Beach COC offered three workshops in Qualicum Beach and Bowser addressing small business finances, business communications, and expanding your market.

We strove to offer low cost accessible workshops that could help our business owners gain pragmatic skills to assist in making their business successful.
